## Online Business Resources for You!

**Agricola:** Contains more than 4.8 million articles, chapters, books, theses, patents, software, audiovisual materials, and technical reports on all aspects of agriculture and allied disciplines, including veterinary sciences, entomology, plant sciences, forestry, aquaculture and fisheries, farming, food and nutrition, and earth and environmental sciences.

**Business Abstracts & Full-Text:** Offers full-text articles from hundreds of key publications, and provides access to product evaluations, interviews, biographical sketches, corporate profiles, statistical rankings and more.

**Business Source Complete:** Covers all areas of business, including marketing, management, MIS, POM, accounting, finance and economics. Additional full-text content includes financial data, reference works, proceedings, case studies, investment research reports, industry and market reports, country reports, company profiles, SWOT analyses, and more.

**Computer Source:** Contains nearly 300 full-text journals and magazines on computer science, programming, artificial intelligence, cybernetics, information systems, robotics, and software.

**Internet and Personal Computing Abstracts:** provides abstracts and indexing for literature related to personal computing products and developments in business, the Internet, the home, and all other applied areas. Coverage extends back to the 1980s.

**Legal Collection™** offers information the law and topics such as criminal justice, international law, federal law, organized crime, medical, labor & human resource law, ethics, the environment and much more.

**Science & Technology Collection:** Contains more than 820 full-text journals covering aspects of the scientific and technical community. Topics include aeronautics, astrophysics, biology, chemistry, computer technology, engineering, microbiology, plant biotechnology, geology, aviation, physics, archaeology, marine sciences and materials science.

**Small Business Reference Center:** Contains more than 450 full-text reference books and nearly 400 full-text periodicals that provide detailed “how-to” instructions to address small business topics, such as buying and selling a business, managing employees, writing a business plans, understanding legal information, a business and much more.

**Small Engine Repair Reference Center:** Provides repair guides for small engines *and* routine maintenance as well as extensive repairs (engine and transmission disassembly) and is searchable by product type, brand, model/engine type, and model numbers.
